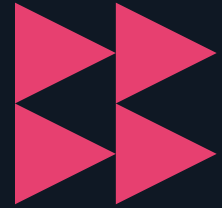

License Dashboard Discovery provides detailed information of each device, including:

- Device name and domain
- Operating system and service pack level
- Device type
- IP address
- The last time the device made contact with the server

An extensive overview of the hardware and operating system configuration of each device is provided, and the installed software list for each device, including manufacturer name, product name and version.

Software usage metering and file scan

Detailed information of the software products that are being used on each device, including:

- Product details
- How often it was started
- How long it was run for
- When it was last used
- Who the user is

A full list of the executable files on each device including the filename, path, size, and executable file header detailing manufacturer, product, description, and version. This highly detailed information can be exported for use by applications including License Manager, which provide software and licence type recognition.

License Dashboard Discovery provides a list of folders that could not be scanned for each device, due to permissions or encryption, helping to identify the potential risks of missing EXE file details.

Detailed and comprehensive summary reports of the available information within the inventory are included. Advanced reporting is also available through third-party reporting tools, such as Microsoft Excel to query the data directly within the database
